

Paper Recycle Unit

Paper is used by every one now days but people generally throw it after use so keeping it in focuss organization under "CLEAN India project" has installed a paper recycle unit in St. Atulanand residential academy, Holapur, in which paper is produced by the recycled paper and used for making letter pad, Card, Envelop, files etc. its capacity is 500 papers of A3 Size.

Gramin (Village Resource Center)

Organization has started 25 village resources center at Ramnagar block of Jaunpur districts with an aim to provide education (Literacy and computer knowledge), formation of self help groups and provide employment, production of high quality seeds and medicinal plants and to provide market for it. Along with it to solve other agricultural related problems and to provide training to them.

NASDEAP Programme

Organization has started a "National Sustainable Development and Environment Awareness Programme" (NASDEAP) in 2010 in which environment scientist, agricultural experts, Doctors, research scholars etc. are associated and Rs. 2 is taken as token money to join this programme. This project cover 22 types of environment related programme with which approximately 3500 children of 35 schools are associated.

Cleanliness and water conservation

Realizing the aim of "Clean India and healthy India" concept, organization under JOCHNICK project and with the cooperation of D.A. (Development Alternatives) has constructed modern toilets and wash basins along with water filters for clean drinking water in 20 schools of Varanasi districts in the entire 20 schools group of 50-50 wash ambassador has been formed and training has been provided to them regarding cleanliness and water conservation. Two schools out of 20 schools have been raised as model school in which electronic incinerator for hygiene and cleanliness has been provided to girl students.

Efforts for a Global Future

Society for Social action and Research (SSAR Sansthan) is working with an aim to encourage basic environmental development, keeping in view the basic objective of the social interests and is running various programmes for above purposes. Organization with help of school children and community is running different programmes for the fundamental development of the society.

Environment Management

Global warming and climate change have become most vital issue at present in the world and this natural disaster can be prevented only through plants which are protection can be prevented only through plants which are protection of the nature by providing us fresh air and by keeping the atmosphere pollution free.

Varanasi is an ancient city which few decades be fare had thousands of ponds, lakes and greenery around the city but it has now gradually turned into concrete jungle.

In order to bring a change and improvement in this organization has covered a major potion of the colonies, hospitals, stadium and various gram sabhas land by the plants and trees , out of which 75 % of it are still safe and secure till now. These plants and trees are mainly of Peepal, Neem, Arjun, Sheesham, Bel, Balamkheera, Aawala, Guava, Parijat and other medicinal plants.

Water management and water harvesting.

Water resource has an important place in all the natural resources $\frac{3}{4}$ land area of the earth is covered by water but in Practical only 0.03% of the total water available on earth is easily accessible by us for our daily use.

In order to save, protect and conserve the water resources our organization is working in different ways n the Varanasi, Jaunpur, Azamgarh districts of U.P. and some areas of Gujarat training is being provided those the rural farmer regarding Drop irrigation, LEPA (Low Energy precision application) and springklar methods of irrigation besides this training for the construction of check dams on small rivers or rainy session drains flowing in the villagers is also



being provided to them . construction process is proposed in few districts by which 60% water could b e saved.

In urban areas, 90% of the rain water is wasted as it goes into rivers by the drains for its conservation; organization is working for the treatment of the domestic waste water and for roof top water harvesting system.

Waste Management and Vermi Culture

Every body ling the houses bring out garbage less are more. This garbage can is dividing into two categories.

1. **Bio Degradable waste**
2. **Non Bio Degradable waste**

The focus on the disposal of domestic waste is being given more in last few years because it is taking shape of major problems now.

Organization is successfully working on the waste disposal plan in different colonies, school, campus and rural areas of the villages. The by product of agriculture is being used to prepare manure and organization is providing training for the construction of vermin pits and simple pits for this purpose. Urban and rural region of Azamgarh, Varanasi and Jaunpur district are included for this plan.

Training and workshop

Imbalance growth in population directly affects the environment when ever human being has tried to extract the use of Air, water and land excessively or improperly, it has resulted into pollution.

Keeping in view these problems, organization conducts 10% of its program schedule for water management, vermiculture, horticulture, social and ecofriendly products, agricultural development, medicinal plants and other social and contemporary issues. over whelming response of these programme are being seen now organization under this project has installed water filters in 20 schools of Varanasi by which thousands of students are being benefitted.
